VETERANS APPLY FOR EDUCATIONAL BENEFITS:

Online at www.gibill.va.gov and click on Apply for GI Bill ® Benefits. Follow the instructions on the web page. Choose from the following forms:

- 22-1990 If you have served in the military and/or are applying for education benefits for the first time.
- 22-1990E If you are a dependent using spouse or parent's Post 9/11 GI Bill ® benefits
- 22-1995 Veterans changing schools.
- 22-5490 If you are a dependent (spouse or child) of a deceased or 100% disabled Veteran applying for education benefits for the first time.
- 22-5495 If you are a dependent changing schools.

GI Bill ® RECIPIENTS:

Submit your Certificate of Eligibility Letter to the VTC Veterans Certifying Official in the Registrar's Office. (Note: This letter will be mailed to you by the VA once they have processed your application for VA benefits). If you are a dependent using a family member's benefit, you will also need to provide their Military Connected family members Social Security Number or VA File number. Your Veteran's Educational benefits will be certified at the end of the Add/Drop period. Please note that the typical time between application for benefits and notice of eligibility from the VA is approximately 4-6 weeks. The typical time for receipt of benefits after school certification is 4-12 weeks. In order to receive your benefits in a timely manner, please plan accordingly.

☐ MILITARY SPOUSES RECIPIENTS:

☐ TUITION ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS:

If you will be utilizing Federal Tuition Assistance, once you've registered for classes, you need to submit your request to your respective Military Education Services Office (GoArmyEd, VT Air Guard, Marine ESO, etc.) for approval. Your TA Authorization form (issued by your ESO) should be submitted to VTC's Student Accounts Office by the first day of classes in order to avoid being dropped from classes.
